## A Brief History Of Flasks

My first introduction to flasks came at the young age of eight, in 1969 ...

My dad and I were big hockey fans (and still are actually!). He held season tickets for the Chicago Blackhawks at the gone-but-not-forgotten Chicago Stadium. I was more than eager to tag along any time he wanted to take me to a game.

Back then, let's just say sporting event security was a little looser than it is today. Rather than paying a high price for a drink at the Stadium, my dad would buy a 7-Up or Coca Cola at the concession stand.

I knew what came next ...

He'd slip a shiny silver flask from his jacket pocket and pour part of the contents into the soft drink. Then, after the 1<sup>st</sup> period, he'd repeat the ritual and enjoy his second and final cocktail of the evening.

I never thought much of it, until one pregame when my dad pulled out the flask, ready to perform his ritual. Unbeknownst to him, two young guys in their early 20's were seated right behind us, observing his cocktail skills.

One of them remarked ... “**Now *that's* one really cool dude!**” ...

From that day forward, the uniqueness (or “coolness” if you will) of flasks captured my attention. It's been a long time since 1969, but flasks are still part of the cultural landscape - and they're more popular than ever.

My wife Laura and I developed [www.FlaskMarket.com](http://www.FlaskMarket.com) as a way to introduce

Actually, flasks have been around for centuries. Flasks as we know them today were introduced in the late 1800's, when specific metals were found to not adversely affect the liquor within the vessel.

Centuries before, flasks were common in Scandinavian countries. Nordic warriors and explorers needed a means to transport alcohol over long sea journeys. The traditional flask, long and narrow in shape, was made from processed animal skin. This somewhat crude design endured until metalworking craftsmanship emerged.

Today, flasks are mostly made from stainless steel, pewter, or plastic. Each of these metals is ideal for protecting the taste and character of the beverage within.

Conceptually, flasks are still used as a discrete manner to transport your favorite drink. They're ideal for picnics, tailgating parties, or at neighborhood gatherings. Flasks are equally at home at parties, social events, and other celebrations.

Due to their relatively inexpensive cost, flasks are ideal gifts for just about any occasion. They are particularly popular with guys! In fact, we can say with the utmost confidence that we've never met a guy who wouldn't appreciate receiving a flask as a gift ...

You can actually [customize the flask online](#) with normal formats like JPG, PNG, or GIF files.

**Tip:** Simple clip art or black and white line art works best. Photos are better suited for [custom photo flasks](#) which we'll spotlight on the next page.

These flasks are ideal for corporate recognition events, like retirement parties or team building sessions ...

## Custom Photo Flasks

For the ultimate personal gift or memento, [custom photo flasks](#) are an ideal choice. Best of all, the process is ultra simple ... all you need to do is upload a photo ... and the flask designer does the rest!



Perfect for anniversaries, Father's Day, or even as a groomsman gift, you won't go wrong with a [custom photo flask](#). Any personal photo that's in a digital image can be uploaded and that's all there is to it ...

**Tip:** The more pixels your photo has, the better your image will turn out. Files supported for a custom photo flask include jpg, gif, tif, bmp, and png. The only type of image you can't use is something that is trademarked.

The flask itself is stainless steel and the photo is protected with an ultra durable epoxy to prevent it from ever chipping or fading ...

## Pin Up Girl Flasks

Ok ... this one is more geared toward the guys. It's the classic Vargas girl images embedded onto the front of a flask.

There are almost a dozen designs of these unique [pin up girl flasks](#), so take a peek at all the designs and choose your favorite. Here's one we like, an old school yell leader cheering on her team:



These are six ounce stainless steel flasks, so they will literally last a lifetime and beyond. Just like the custom photo flasks, these [pin up girl flasks](#) have protective clear epoxy coating to protect the image from just about anything you can inflict ...

A wooden gift box and funnel for the flask are also available if you're planning to give one of these as a gift ...

## **Armed Forces Flasks**

We are proud to spotlight these flasks to honor the Armed Forces and all the men and women who serve our country ...



The **armed forces flask** showcases the Army emblem in pewter and embedded on a six ounce stainless steel flask.

These designs are also available for the other branches of the service, like the Marines, Navy, and Air Force, as well as public safety entities like police and fire departments.

These flasks made an ideal recognition gift for anyone serving in the armed forces, particularly for a welcome home celebration!

The cell phone flask holds 3.5 ounces, is about five inches tall, and comes with a carrying case with a belt clip ...

## Flask and Cigar Holder

We haven't smoked stogies in a while, but if we did, this would be one of the first things we'd buy ... the flask and cigar holder.

As the name implies, it's a combination flask and a holder for your cigar:



Yeah ... not the greatest picture but the slim design is what makes this flask unique. It easily fits in your shirt pocket ...

If you're looking for a poker party gift, or a thank you gift for the guy who put together the bachelor party ... you won't go wrong with one of these!

## Monogrammed Flasks

Ok ... back to the classy flasks ...

Ideal as a groomsman gift, [monogrammed flasks](#) come in a wide variety of styles, from classic tan leather to black leather to pewter and more.

The images are laser engraved onto the front of a brushed stainless steel flask and covered with a clear epoxy resin to protect against any damage.

## **Flasks For Women**

The flask is about four inches high, hold four ounces, and comes packaged in a classy gift box ...

The classic porthole flask is ideal for sailors, boating enthusiasts, and world travelers! There's even a [modernist porthole flask](#) with a slightly different design that's a bit more angular in shape.

## Walking Cane Flask

For the sophisticated (slightly) older gentleman in your life, we present the [walking cane flask](#) ...

This is no novelty piece, it's a genuine walking stick/cane that allows one to take a brief break from their walk to enjoy a libation. It looks like an ordinary walking cane on the outside ... but it screws open to reveal six 2 oz. Small compartments for liquid refreshment!



The cane is three feet in length and is made of sturdy black aluminum that supports 250 pounds, although keep in mind that most people only exert about 1/3 of their actual weight as pressure on the cane.

To top it all off, there's a handsome brass hand piece on top to complete the sophisticated look of this dual purpose flask ...

## **Dopp Kit With Flask**

Not a flask unto itself per se, but a Dopp Kit that's ideal for travel, with a flask included ...

***History Lesson Time Out:*** Do you know what the term “[dopp kit](#)” means? In simple terms, it's a small leather bag containing mens shaving supplies, comb, grooming scissors, and other personal care supplies. It was named after its creator, Charles Doppelt, an English leatherworker. The term “dopp kit” became common vernacular during and after World War II.



Here's what's included in the [Dopp Kit](#) :

- Leather bound 5 oz. Flask
- Wine corkscrew
- Deck of cards
- Grooming scissors
- Nail clipper
- Tweezers
- Nail file
- Shoe horn
- Complete shoe shine kit

## **Girls Night Out Flask**

Hey guys, here's the ultimate “honey, just go out and have a great time, I'm secure in my manhood” gift ... the **girls night out flask**.

This sassy flask celebrates the martini culture and is emblazoned with the words “Girls Night Out” on the front. It's wrapped in faux pink leather and easily fits into all but the smallest of purses and handbags (it stand 4.5 inches tall and holds six ounces).



Ladies, this is a perfect gift for all your best girl friends, because ... well you know ... sometimes guys don't think of these kinds of gifts! Ideal as a **bridesmaid gift** too ...
